appointed and sworn, under, and by virtue

of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever,  
within the Said Parish, is Nine hundred  
and Ninety pounds by the Year - which sum  
of Nine hundred and Ninety pounds, is due  
and payable, to the Dean and Chapter  
and Vicars Choral, of the Cathedral of St.  
Finbarr, Cork, as a Composition for the  
Tithes, claimable by them, as Owners of  
the Rectorial, Vicarial, and Appropriate  
Tithes of the Said Parish -
