

I Edwyn Hoskyns (Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act, in such case made and provided, for fixing and ascertaining a true and just Compensation for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of St. Georges in the Diocese and County of Dublin) do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Compensation for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Three pounds Three shillings and six pence halfpenny by the year. Which sum of £8..3..6<sup>½</sup> is due and Payable to The Rev. Arthur Smyth Adamson as a Compensation for the Tithes claimed by him as Lessee of the Dean and Chapter of Christ Church.

And I do further certify that the average Price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in said Co. for the Period of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Nov. 1830 is £1..12..0<sup>½</sup> per barrel
