

find that the other Churches in the aforesaid parishes are ruined and demolished  
and doe so continue and are inconveniently placed in respect of the  
union and that the Church of Sligo lately repaired as aforesaid is the place  
where the now Incumbent of the aforesaid Churches doth serve the Cure, -  
and is seated much about the Center of the said Parishes, and wee judge also  
that the Inhabitants of the said Parishes are soe poore that they are not  
able to build upp there respective Churches and that the profits of the  
said Churches are soe small that they afford but a slender subsistance to the  
present Incumbent and that they may be most conveniently united to  
the parish of St Johns aforesaid where the Parishioners and Inhabitants  
of the severall parishes aforesaid may at all times resort with great ease  
and convenience the exchaung of the said parishes not being at too  
great a distance from the said towne of Sligo and in pursuance of the said  
act of Parliament wee thinke it fitting that the aforesaid parishes be  
united into one intire parish and be forever hereafter deemed reputed  
and constituted one parish vnder the name of the Rectory or parish of  
St Johns aforesaid and that the Church lately repaired in the towne of  
Sligo aforesaid be forever hereafter the Church Church of the Rectory  
or parish of St Johns aforesaid Provided allwayes that the Churches  
and Churchyards of the said Parishes united as aforesaid to the Rectory  
of St Johns aforesaid be forever hereafter duly preserved from all  
impairment, and that also all first fruits, twentieth part, and other dues  
to his Maie<sup>ties</sup> alsoe all accustomed dues, John Lord Archbishop of  
Tuam Bannock and Metropolitan of the Province of Connaught and  
John Lord Bp of Elphin and to our Successors Archbishops of Tuam  
and Bishops of Elphin bee duly saved and preserved unto us and  
them out of the said parishes be to be united as aforesaid as alsoe all  
other accustomed right and due therout to the Archbishop of Elphin  
and the fees belonging to the Registers of Tuam and Elphin for  
the time being always saved and preserved soe that wee and they and  
every of us and them may for ever enjoy the same in as large ample  
and beneficiall manner as if this Union had never beene made  
And wee are further humbly of opinion that whereas the aforesaid  
Bishop of Elphin is patron in right of that See of the Parishes of  
Calry, Killasbegrowne, Killmarkowen and St Johns and Rectory  
of the same interdues parishes that for ever hereafter from such tyme as  
the said Bp shall take effect the said Bishop of Elphin and his Successors shall  
have the presentation of the same Rectory or parish of St Johns for ever thus  
united and constituted as aforesaid and John Lord Bishop of Elphin being  
Patron of the Parishes of Calry, Killasbegrowne, Killmarkowen and St Johns  
and Rectory of the same interdues parishes doe hereby give my consent under  
my hand and Seale to the above mentioned union as by the Act is required  
And wee John Lord Archbishop of Tuam and John Lord Bp of Elphin  
furth
