

To all to whom these Presents shall come, I, the Reverend *Charles Hamilton*  
Incumbent of the Parish of *Saint John's*

in the County of Sligo, send greeting, WHEREAS pursuant to the Provisions of an Act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty King William the 4th, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," *Knox Barrett of Colga in the County of Sligo Esquire, has truly served me with a notice in writing in the words and figures following*

SIR,

You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th Years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make

such Compositions permanent," I *Knox Barrett of Colga in the County of Sligo, who am seized in freehold of all that and those, the Lands of Lonnegagh containing one hundred and fifty Acres, English Statute Measure, or thereabout bounded on the North, by Land held by Hetherington and Duke, on the South by Garrowroe, on the East by Tawnafobile and Cairns, and on the West by Knockmegany road and also the Lands of Galtragh containing about sixteen Acres English Statute Measure, bounded on the North by Lands of Lord Palmerston's, on the South by Thomas Mathews on the East by Knockmegany Road, and on the West by Knocktohill*

do hereby signify to you *my*

— desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tythes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to *me*

a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring

*me* entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
