

March. By the Lord Lieutenant and Council

Whereas in an Act of Parliament made in this Kingdom
in a Session beginning the seventeenth of April in the Tenth
year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord Charles the Second
Intituled an Act for re-union and Division of Parishes and
Concerning Churches Free schools and Exchanges there
is a Clause Inserted in these words *That* be it enacted
therefore by the Kings most Excellent Majesty with
the Assent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporall
and Commons in this present Parliament Assembled
and by the Authority thereof that from and after
the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel which
shall be in the year of Our Lord one Thousand
Six hundred Sixty Two for and During the
Term of Twenty years from thence next ensuing
it shall be Lawfull for the Lord Lieutenant or
Lords Deputies Lords Justices or other Chief
Governor or Governors of this Kingdom for
the time being with the Assent of six or more
of the Privy Council and with the Advice and
Approbation of the Arch bishop of the Province
and the Bishop of the Diocess and with the
Consent of the Respective Parsons and Incumbents
to unite Parishes and Dissolve them and to make
Exchanges
