

Convenience the best part of the said Parishes  
not being at too great a Distance from the Town of  
Sligo, and in pursuance of the P. Act of Parliament.  
We think it fitting that the aforesaid Parishes be united  
into one entire Parish and be for ever hereafter  
deemed reputed and constituted one Parish under  
the name of the Rectory or Parish of St. Johns aforesaid  
and that the Church lately repaired in the Town of  
Sligo aforesaid be for ever hereafter the Parish Church  
of the Rectory or Parish of St. Johns aforesaid provided  
always that the Church and Churchyard of the  
said Parishes united as aforesaid to the Rectory of  
St. Johns aforesaid be for ever hereafter duly  
preserved from all profane uses and that  
also all First Tithes Twentieth part and  
other Dues to his Majesty as also all  
Accustomed dues to his John Lord Archbishop  
of Tuam Primate and Metropolitan of the  
Province of Conaught and John Lord Bishop  
of Elphin and to their Successors Archbishops  
of Tuam and Bishops of Elphin be duly  
paid and preserved unto us and  
them out of the said Parishes so
