You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th Years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I

do hereby signify to you by the Authority given to me and on behalf of the said Thomas Ormsby do desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tythes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to the said Thomas Ormsby a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring him entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
