appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the
Fourth intituled "An Act for the Establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain a
fixed and just Composition for all tithes arising growing
yielded & payable within the parish of Saint John, being
Members of the perpetual Manse of Saint John's
in the County of Sligo, do Certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all tithes (whenever they
arising and payable from the Fisheries and Excepted)
within the said Parish is three hundred and twenty
Pounds by the year of which Sum of three hundred
and twenty Pounds the whole and entire Amount
is due and payable to the Rev. Charles Hamilton
as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as
Rector & Cur of the said Parish.

And We do further Certify that the average
price of oats being the grain principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending on the
first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence
farthing per barrel given under our hand at Sligo
this thirtieth day of October 1823. three
