these Presents shall come, I, the Reverend Charles Hamilton
Incumbent of the Parish of *Calry*
in the County of Sligo, send greeting, WHEREAS pursuant to the Provisions of an Act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty King William the 4th, intituled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," *George Dedmore of Kinsinstown in the County of Sligo Esq.* has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, *on behalf of and by the authority of John Hollis Esq.* in the words and figures following

SIR,

You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I *George Dedmore of Kinsinstown in the County of Sligo Agent to and for John Hollis Esq.* Express who is seized in Fee simple of all that and there the lands of *Calry* containing *Four hundred and fifty two Acre* Eighty *Acres* and *one* *Quarter* of an Acre, the Messes and bounds thereof are as follows viz bounded on the North by *Ballyglass & Ballymoe* on the East by *Lernagh* on the South by *Cloughmoe* and on the West by *Killycassell & Loughgale*, which lands are situate in the Parish of *Calry* Barony of *Carbery & Coligny*

Do hereby signify to you by the Authority given to me, and on behalf of the said *John Hollis* his desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tythes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to the said *John Hollis* the Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring him entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters

on your part required by the said Act to be done.
