in the County of Sligo, send greeting, WHEREAS pursuant to the Provisions of an Act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty King William the 4th, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent,"

George Dodwell of Rensfort in the County of Sligo Esquire, has truly served me with a notice in writing on behalf of ~~the Trustees of the said Parish of Saint John's~~
in the words and Figures following -

SIR,

You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th Years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make

such Compositions permanent," I George Dodwell of Rensfort in the County of Sligo, Agent to and for ~~the Trustees of the said Parish of Saint John's~~ who is seized in Freehold of all that and those the Lands of Ballydoogan containing One Hundred & Twenty Six acres English Statute Measure or thereabouts the metes and bounds whereof are as follow. viz bounded on the North by part of Ballydoogan on the East by Oakfield on the South by Ballydoogan and on the West by Calhagh

Do hereby signify to you by the authority given to me and on behalf of ~~the said Parish of Saint John's~~ ^{me} desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tythes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to ~~the said Parish of Saint John's~~ ^{me} a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring ~~the said Parish of Saint John's~~ ^{me} entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
