an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of George
the Fourth. Intituled, an Act to provide for the establish-
-ing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited
-time, to ascertain and fix a true & just composition
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Rathlone in the County of Westmeath
Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Com-
-position for all tithes aforesaid within said Parish
of Rathlone is 330 ^l pounds by the year. The whole of
which sum of 330 ^l pounds is due and payable to
the Revd James Pitt-Ruffell as Rector & Vicar of the
said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average price of
oats being the corn principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending on the first day
of November 1821 per - is 15. ¹/₂ shillings ¹/₂ pence for the bush.
