the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time according to the directions
of the said Act, and according to Equity and good
Conscience, and without Favor or Affection, Prejudice
or Malice, to any person or persons whomsoever,
Sworn before me

for the County Westmeath
this 3rd Day of March 1824
