

Warrant of Composition for all tithes in the parish
of St. Paul's, Diocese of Down and City of Killybegs -

We John Wood of Down in the County of
Killybegs and Joseph Longman of the City of
Killybegs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of King George the fourth intitled an act
to provide for the reestablishing of composition for
tithes in Ireland for a limited time to wit
and for a time and just composition for all tithes
arising growing due or payable within the parish
of St. Paul in the Diocese of Down and County of
the City of Killybegs do hereby certify that the
just amount of composition for all tithes what
soever within the said parish is fifty pounds
sterling by the year which sum is due and payable
to Robert Lord Bishop of Down as a composition
for the tithes payable by the said parish

And we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the average price of grain
in that County of the City of Killybegs for the period
of seven years ending the first day of January 1801
is one pound sixteen shillings and eight pence half
being the price for barrel
