## Parish of Saint Marys, Drogheda, Diocese of Meath.

I Frederick W. Edwards, Commissioner for the Parish of Saint Marys Drogheda, Successor of Frederick Norman Esquire late Baronet Do hereby certify that an Agreement was entered into on the 15<sup>th</sup> July 1833 between the Parishioners duly assembled in Vestry and the Representatives of Mr. Norman, the Lay Impropriator of said Parish, for all the Tithes of said Parish, for the annual sum of one hundred and five pounds, which agreement was confirmed in Vestry on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1833 and a Certificate to that effect duly registered in the Diocese of Meath.

By Deeds produced at Vestry bearing date 1770 and 1817, referring to a Lease dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 1770. Mr. Norman covenanted to pay out of the Tithes of said Parish of Saint Marys, to the Vicar of said Parish, two sums of Eighty pounds and Six pounds, Sixteen Shillings and Six pence each annually, being Eighty pounds, two Shillings and Seven pence British - which sums are payable to the Reverend James Crawford, the Vicar of Saint Marys, by the Representatives of Mr. Norman.

I certify that the average price of Oats, being the Corn principally sown in the Parish of Saint Marys for the seven years ending the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1830 according to the Public Gazette is Thirteen Shillings and three pence three farthings per harrill of Poulton Stone.
