By virtue of an act made in the fourth year of
the reign of George the fourth to provide for
the establishing of ~~the~~ the composition of
Tithes in Ireland, and also under the
Acts of the 2^d & 3^d of William the
fourth for making such compositions
general throughout Ireland

Do hereby certify that at a Vestry held in
the Church of St. Mary's Drogheda in the
Year of our Lord 1771. That a composition was agreed
to between the Parson, Vicar, & John Baskford
all of the said parish, for the sum of one
hundred & five pounds per year for the remunera-
tion of the incumbent Vicar, & his
Representatives agreeing to pay out of the above sum
the Vicar's two Tithings & eleven ^{annuities} pounds to the
the Vicar's Curate near said parish of St. Mary's
according to the Deeds of the 21st of September 1771 & the
10th day of March 1772 for the Salary of the Vicar of
said Parish in which sum the small tithes are
included - dated this 15th day of July 1773 - St. Mary's
Curate
