Lord archbishop of Armagh primate and metropolitan
of all Ireland and the Right Honourable Henry Lord Bishop
of Meath of the other Part by which Said Deed the Said
Charles Earl of Drogheda for and in Consideration of
the Sum of one thousand three hundred and twenty pounds
paid to him by the Said Richard Lord archbishop of
Armagh and Henry Lord Bishop of Meath Did grant
Bargain and Sell unto the Said Richard Lord archbishop
of Armagh and Henry Lord Bishop of Meath all that and those
the Rectorie and Impropriate Tithes yearly coming
growing increasing arising and Revening in the Parish of
St Marys Spring and being in the Town and County of the
Town of Drogheda and the Liberties thereof with the
appurtenances to hold unto the Said Richard Lord
archbishop and Henry Lord Bishop of Meath their heirs
and assigns forever which Said Deed and the same are
witnessed by Henry Meredyth and Robert Graham of the City of
Dublin Esqrs (Drogheda Seal) Signed and Sealed in Presence
of Henry Meredyth the Robert Graham
