 the Corporation of Tithes on Monday 15 July 1833  
 for the Parish of St. Mary's in the Diocese of  
 Meath that a Corporation was agreed to for  
 the sum of £105 Pounds by the year from November  
 first next for all Tithes of said Parish due &  
 payable to Mr. John Bask fort as the representative  
 of Isaac Horn Esq. by Deed dated 21 August  
 1771.

We the undersigned agree to the payment of  
 the above sum for Corporation for said Parish  
 being one Hundred & five Pounds  
 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1833
