ascertaining a true and just Composition for
all Tithes arising growing yielded or Payable
within the Parish of St. Marys Dublin) do
hereby certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Nineteen shillings and Eight
pence by the Year. Which sum of 19⁸ is due
and Payable to The Rev. Arthur Smyth Adami-
son as a Composition for the Tithes claimed
by him as Lessee of the Dean and Chapter
of Christ Church.

And I do further Certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the Period of Seven Years
ending on the first of Nov. 1830 is £1.12.0⁰
to Barrel.
