the fourth Year of the Reign of George
the fourth entitled an Act to provide
for the Establishing of Compositions for
tithes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and Just
Composition for all tithes arising -
growing yielding and payable within the
Parish of St Michael in the Diocese
of Cork do hereby Certify that the true
and Just Amount of Composition for
all tithes whatsoever within the said
parish is one Hundred and forty pounds
Four Shillings and Seven pence in the
Year as due and payable to the
Reverend Edward Mitchell Carleton
Prebendary or Rector of said parish
and we do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the corn principal-
ly grown in this County for the period
of seven years ending on the first
day of November 1821 is one pound eight
Shillings and eight pence half pence per Bushel
