

Palace, Cashel, 29th May 1826.

a proposal having been this day submitted by the
Deconomist to the Chapter of Cashel, from the parishioners
of St Patrick's Rock, offering the sum of Two hun-
-dred and twenty pounds sterling as a yearly compo-
-sition for the tythes claimable from the said Parish
by the Deconomy of the Cathedral of Cashel -
It was determined by the members of the said
Chapter then present that this proposal be declined.

at the same time, the Chapter expressed its
full readiness to enter into a contract for the said
Tythes, whenever an adequate offer shall be made;
or to come under the averages of the seven years
(1815 - 1821) according to the directions of the Act.
