Produced a Document in Writing declining
their acceptance of £220 being the sum proposed
by the Parishioners — At the same time and
place John Scully of the Town of Lifford Esq^r
was Elected nominated and appointed
Commissioner on behalf of the Landholders
and occupiers of Land within the Parish
for the purposes of said Acts — and at the
same time and place Archdeacon Cotton
on the part and behalf of the Dean and
Chapter Nominates and appoints William
Palmer of Harcourtstreet in the City of
Dublin Esq^r Commissioner on behalf of
the Dean and Chapter and which latter
Denomination the different other Tyth
Proprietors respectively agrees —

Robert Linton of the City of Cashel Gent^l
agrees to accept of the Annual sum of one
Hundred & seventy pounds. 15-5-^{3/4} United Currency
for his proportion of the Tyths of said parish
and which sum the Respective Landholders
of the Respective Lands subject to the same agree
to pay in such proportions as shall be ascertain-
ed by the aforesaid Commissioners —
