

# Parish of St. Nicholas — County of Cork — Diocese of Cork.

I, John Kidd, Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth Intituled 'An Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of St. Nicholas in the Diocese of Cork and in the County of Cork. Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Saint Nicholas in the Diocese

**Total.** £165.14.0 aforesaid is One Hundred and Sixty Five Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence by the Year. Of which sum of One Hundred and Sixty Five Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence the sum of Fifty Seven Pounds Fourteen Shillings is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> John Newman Lombard as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish. Of said sum of One Hundred and Sixty Five Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence the sum of Sixty Two Pounds Four Shillings and Nine Pence is due and payable to Mess<sup>rs</sup> John and Robert Meade for and during the Term of Forty Years from the 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1819. and by virtue of a Lease unto them granted by the said Bishop of Cork, who is by Royal Patent, Trustee of the Amount of Tithes for certain purposes specified in said Royal Patent. The said sum of Sixty two Pounds Four Shillings and Nine Pence is the amount of Composition for Tithes growing yielded and payable out of that part of the Parish of St. Nicholas from Saint John of Jerusalem. Of the above sum of One Hundred and Sixty Five Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence the sum of Forty Pounds Sixteen Shillings and Four Pence is due and payable to the Lessees of the Mayor and Aldermen of the Staple under and by virtue of Leases unto said Lessees granted in perpetuity by said Corporation as Trustees of Baron Worth's, Charitable bearing date in 1708. The remainder of the above sum of One Hundred and Sixty Five Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence that is to say the sum of Four Pounds Nineteen Shillings and Nine Pence is the property of W. Deble under and by virtue of certain deeds conveying to said Deble the Interest of the aforesaid Baron Worth in certain parts of the land now known by the name of Sinochroan. Said Baron Worth having been the owner of said Tithes with the said Leases of Royal Charter.

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of Wheat during the 7 Years ending on the first day of November 1830 (thirty) is One Pound Twelve Shillings and One Halfpenny per Barrell and that the price of Oats during the same period is Twelve Shillings and Eleven Pence Halfpenny per Barrell. Wheat and Oats being the Corn principally grown in said County of Cork.
