Copy of Certificate

I John Kidd, Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of King William the fourth, intituled - "An Act to Amend three Acts, passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the ~~ascertaining~~ of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland; and to make such Compositions permanent. (16<sup>th</sup> August 1832) to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within that part of the parish of St Nicholas, County of Cork, called Maglene, do hereby certify, that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said part of said Parish is Twenty one pounds by the Year. The whole of which sum is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> John Newman Lombard as Rector of said Church of St Nicholas and Chancellor of the Diocese of Cork. And I do further certify, that the average price of wheat for the period of seven years ending on first day of November 1830, was One pound Twelve shillings and one half penny # Barrel; and that the average price of oats during the same period was Twelve shillings and Eleven pence Halfpenny # Barrel; wheat and oats being the Corn principally grown in the said County of Cork.
