Copy of Proceedings of the Special Vestry.

Be it Remembered that as a special Vestry, duly called and assembled, in the Parish Church of the Parish of Tallaght for the Parish of Tallaght in the County of Dublin on Friday the 12th of May 1826 of persons qualified according to the provisions of an Act of Parliament made and passed in the fourth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the fourth, entitled "An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, for a limited," and of an Act made and passed in the fifth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to amend an Act of the last session of Parliament for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, for the purpose of taking into consideration the foregoing Certificate of the Commissioners for said Parish, appointed under and by virtue of the said Acts of Parliament, in pursuance of public notice having been given in the said Parish Church on Sunday the 30th of April last, and of the said notice having been posted on the said Parish Church, and on the Roman Catholic Chapel in said Parish seven days before the day therein appointed for holding the said Vestry of the time and place of holding the same and the special purpose thereof—

The foregoing Certificate having been taken into due and mature consideration, by the said Special Vestry so assembled as aforesaid, It was agreed upon and Resolved by the said Special Vestry, on behalf of all the Owners and Occupiers of Land in said Parish that the said Certificate of the Commissioners be and is hereby approved of and that the same do stand, approved of and confirmed accordingly, no appeal being necessary or expedient on account of the same—

And it was further Agreed upon and Resolved to by the said Special Vestry on behalf of all the owners and occupiers of Land in said Parish that the amount of Composition in said Certificate mentioned shall be invariable for the Term of Twenty one years from the 1st of May Instant Instant—
