Copy of Certificate of Composition for part of the Parish of Swords in the Diocese of Dublin.

I Arthur Battersby Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the reign of His present Majesty King William the Fourth entitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within those parts of the Parish of Swords in the Diocese of Dublin known as the Lands of Rathbeal Shidaw and Killaghe. Do hereby Certify the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever within those parts of the parish of Swords above named is one hundred and sixty eight pounds three shillings and five pence half penny sterling by the year which is due and payable to the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of St. Patrick Dublin in the following proportions that is to say the sum of sixty nine pounds seven shillings and seven pence half penny from off the Lands of Rathbeal the sum of sixty two pounds eleven shillings and four pence three farthings from off the Lands of Shidaw and the sum of thirty six pounds four shillings and five pence one farthing from off the Lands Killaghe making together the first mentioned sum of one hundred and sixty eight pounds three shillings and five pence half penny sterling And I do further Certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principal grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is thirty two shillings and one half penny per Barrel
