

We Thomas Gibbon Fitz Gibbon and Henry Bowles Esquires Commissioners  
 duly appointed and Sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth  
 year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the  
 Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a Limited time") to  
 Ascertain and fix a true and Just composition for all and Singular Tithes arising  
 growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Saint Nicholas in the County of  
 the City of Limerick and Diocess of Limerick; Do hereby Certify that at a Special  
 Vestry held in the Vestry Room of the Cathedral Church of the Blessed Virgin  
 Mary Limerick pursuant to the aforesaid Act and also of the Act of the fifth of  
 George the Fourth entitled "An Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parlia-  
 ment for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland"  
 It was unanimously agreed to pay the Very Reverend Arthur John Preston In-  
 cumbent of the said Parish of Saint Nicholas the Sum of Two Hundred and  
 Thirty five pounds Str per Annum for a Term of Twenty one years without any  
 Variation in the price of Corn as a Composition for all & Singular the Tithes of said  
 Parish, which was accepted and Agreed to by the said Incumbent and Approved  
 of by the Right Rev The Lord Bishop of the said Diocess as appears by a Writing and  
 Agreement under the hand of the Chairman of said Vestry and eight other  
 persons duly qualified to vote thereat with the Signature of the said Incumbent  
 and the said Lord Bishops approval thereto. We therefore in pursuance of the  
 Powers vested in us by said Acts Do hereby Certify that the above mentioned  
 Sum of Two Hundred and Thirty five pounds Str per Annum is the true  
 and Just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever payable within the said  
 Parish of Saint Nicholas to continue, be in force and Payable for and during  
 the term of Twenty one years without any Variation as aforesaid. —  
 Given under our hands Seals this 29 day of October 1825 Five. —

And we do further Certify that the Average  
 price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said  
 Parish for the period of seven years ending on the 1st  
 day of November 1822 is £1. 18. 8/3 per Barrell
