

what variation should be made under the said Statutes in the Composition for Tithes and rent charge in lieu of composition payable in such parish, and it appearing to the Justices presiding at the said Court of Quarter Sessions held at Carlow aforesaid on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1896 by the Original Certificate of composition, dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 1853 and by the evidence produced before said Justices that the average price of Oats per barrel for the seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1850 was £0. 12. 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> per barrel, and that in consequence thereof the Commissioners, appointed pursuant to the Statute in such case made, and provided had fixed the amount of Composition for all Tithes in the said Parish of Saint Mullins at £600 Sterling by the year which composition took effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1854 and that Oats was the measure of composition for said Parish, And it further appearing by the Report in writing of the said Henry A

Coffey under highland, delivered to the chairman and Justices aforesaid that the average price of good marketable oats for the last seven years was £11. 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Sterling per barrel, according to the returns published in the Dublin Gazette, and it appearing that the rent charge payable to the said Lay Impropriator, or those deriving under her in lieu of the composition so claimable by her was the sum of £450. 0. 0 being  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the said sum of £600. 0. 0 and upon hearing the evidence given before the said Justices in open Court It is ordered by the said Justices that the sum of £600. 0. 0 being the composition mentioned in said Certificate, as claimable by the said Lay Impropriator be diminished by a sum of £77. 3. 5 Sterling and that the same shall be £522. 16. 7 annually, and pursuant to the Statute 1 and 2 Victoria Chapter 109 the Rent charge in lieu of composition so far as same is payable to the said Lay Impropriator or those deriving under her shall be  $\frac{3}{4}$  of said
