to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth
fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign
of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing
for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
and to make such Compositions permanent" to
ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Saint Peters formerly Saint Kevins in the
County of Dublin. Do hereby Certify that the true
and Just Amount of Compositions for all Tithes
whatever within the said parish is One hundred and
fifty eight pounds by the Year which Sum of
one hundred and fifty eight pounds is due and
payable to The very Reverend The Dean and Chapter
of Saint Patricks Dublin and I do further Certify that
the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven
years ending on the first day of November in the
year one thousand eight hundred and thirty is
Thirty two Shillings and one half penny per
Barrel
