I John Kidd, Commissioner, duly appointed & sworn, under & by virtue of an Act made in the Second Third years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth, Intituled, "An Act to Amend three" "Acts pass'd respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, & in the" "Seventh & Eighth years of the Reign of His Majesty King" "George the Fourth, providing for the Establishing of" "Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such" "Compositions permanent. (Sixteenth August Eighteen Hun-  
dred & Thirty Two)" to ascertain & fix a true and just Com-  
-position for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or  
payable within the Parish of Salterstown in the County  
of South, do hereby Certify that the true & just Amount  
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said  
Parish is Ninety five pounds Sterling — — — — —  
— — — — — by the year which sum of Ninety five pounds  
x — — — — — is due & payable to Dame  
Nester Frances Bellingham widow & relict of Sir William  
Bellingham Baronet deceased, under & by virtue of the last  
will and testament of the said Sir William Bellingham who  
was possessed thereof under & by virtue of a Deed of assign-  
-ment for the residue of a term of 999 years (commencing from  
the year 1764)

And I do further Certify that the average  
price of Wheat during the Seven years ended first November  
Eighteen Hundred & Thirty was One pound Twelve Shillings  
Four Halfpenny & Barrel & that the price of Oats during  
same period was Twelve Shillings and Eleven pence halfpenny Barrel. Wheat  
and Oats being the Corn principally grown in the said  
County
