of March in the thirty sixth year of the Reign of his late Majesty  
King Charles the second and the remainder of said sum of  
four hundred and sixty two pounds is due and payable to His  
Majesty his heirs and successors as a composition for the  
Tithes of the several other lands situate lying and being in said  
parish but We further Certify that the said Reverend Denis  
Browne during the period that he shall continue to be the  
Incumbent of said parish is entitled to receive the entire of said  
sum of four hundred and sixty two pounds inasmuch as it  
appears to us that by a certain Lease bearing date the fourth day  
of September one thousand eight hundred and twenty one the  
Chief Commissioners of His Majestys Ireland Excise and Taxes  
in Ireland demised the said last mentioned Tithes to the said  
Denis Browne during the time that he should continue Vicar  
or Incumbent of said parish.

And we further Certify that the average price of  
Oats being the corn principally grown in such County for the  
period of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821  
is fifteen shillings per Barrel.
