Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue
of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King
George the Fourth intituled an Act to provide for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited Time; to ascertain and fix a True and just
Composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Scurloctstown in the County
of Meath. do hereby Certify that the True and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is one Hundred and thirty nine pounds and six by the Year. of
which sum the sum of Twenty four pounds British are due
and payable yearly to the Rev^d. Richard Butler as a Com-
position for the Tithes Claimable by him as Curate of the said
Parish, and the sum of One Hundred and thirty five pounds
and six are due and payable yearly to Joseph of the Esqr. as a
Composition for the Tithes Claimable by him as Lay Impro-
priator of the said Parish; And We do further Certify
the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of Seven Years
ending on the first day of November in the Year
one Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty one, is one
pound eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny
Irish per Barrel Given under our Hands this 15th day of
April 1828, Light,
