Diocese of Ossory the 11th day of
January 1834*

I Henry Baskel Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an act made in the 2nd and 3rd of William
the fourth to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding, or payable within
the Parish of Shambough in the County of Kilkenny do hereby
Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for
Tithes whatsoever within the said parish is Eighty two
pounds Nineteen Shillings by the year, of which sum of
Fifty five pounds Six Shillings, Two third parts are due
and payable to the Corporation of Waterford, or their assigns,
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by them as owners
of the Rectorial Tithes. The remaining one third part is due
and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Wallis as owner of the
Vicarial Tithes, and I do further Certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said
County for the period of Seven Years ending the 1st day
of November 1830 is one pound Twelve Shillings and
one Half penny
