

Tithe Certificate

Received in the Register of the
Diocese of Ossory this 2nd day
of January 1834

I Henry Castel Commissioner duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and
third of William the fourth to ascertain and fix a
true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing,
yielding or payable within the Parish of Stambough in
the County of Kilkenny do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for Tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is Eighty two pounds nineteen
Shillings by the Year, of which sum of Fifty five pounds
six Shillings Two third parts are due and payable to the
Cooperation of Waterford or their Assigns as a Composition
for the Tithe Claimable by them as owners of the Vicarual
Tithe. The remaining one third part is due and payable
to the Rev^d Thomas Wallis as owner of the Vicarual Tithe
and I do further certify that the average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in said County for
the period of seven years ending the 1st day of
November 1830 is one pound Twelve Shillings and
one Half penny
