

I Thomas Edward Peily a commissioner duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an act passed in the second and third years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the fourth, entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Shekinane, in the Diocese of Limerick and County of Waterford. Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish, is Three hundred and thirty five Pounds, five Shillings and two pence, by the year, which is due and payable to the Reverend Henry Archdall, a Rector and Vicar of said Parish, being the average of the sums agreed for and paid to him the said Henry Archdall for seven years preceding the first of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty - increased by one fifth the average
