

I Charles Percival having been duly appointed and sworn  
Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the  
Fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth, intituled,  
An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth,  
fifth, and in the seventh and eighth year of the reign of  
His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the  
establishing of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland. 16<sup>th</sup> August  
1833. To ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for  
all the Tithes, arising, growing, yielded or payable within  
the Parish of Shankill in the County of Kilkenny; do  
hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Com-  
position for all tithes within the said Parish is, Four  
Hundred and ninety Pounds by the year, which Sum  
of Four Hundred and ninety Pounds is due and  
payable to the Rev. Joseph Chapman as a Composition  
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said  
Parish of Shankill in the Diocese of Lichlin and  
Down. - And I do further certify that the average  
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the period <sup>of the</sup> seven years ending the
