time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition  
for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within  
the Parish of Moyne in the County of Meath, do hereby  
Certify that the true and just amount of composition  
for all tithes whatever within the said parish is two  
Hundred and eighty pounds by the year - Of which sum  
of two hundred and eighty pounds the whole is due and  
payable to the Reverend Stephen Radcliffe as a compo-  
sition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the  
said parish -

And we do further certify that the Average  
price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in such  
County, for the period of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of November 1821. is one pound eighteen Shilling  
and eight pence halfpenny per Barrel estimated ac-  
-cording to the late currency of Ireland - Dated  
this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827
