Composition of all Tithes whatever within  
the said parish is Four hundred and  
Eighty pounds Sterling by the year, which  
Sum of Four hundred and Eighty pounds  
Sterling is due and payable to the Reverend  
Gabriel Stokes, Rector and Vicar of said  
parish of Streen as owner of the  
Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes of said  
parish of Streen.
