

and perches as a composition for the tithes thereof.
And we find that one thousand seven hundred and
two acres, two roods and twenty six perches, marked
Third quality and worth one guinea per acre shall
pay the sum of one shilling and two pence half pence
per acre and so in proportion for roods and perches
as a composition for the tithes thereof. And finally
we find that the above mentioned sums payable out
of the above mentioned quantity of land makes the
sum of three hundred and forty four pounds, late Irish
currency being the sum agreed on as a composition
for the tithes of the said parish. All the above sums
are in the late Irish currency and the surveys made
in Irish plantation measure. Given under our hands
