We the undersigned Rt Hon Henry Bruen

Esquires being three owners of land in  
the Parish of Slyquiff each charged with the  
annual payment of £3:0:0 and upwards  
in respect of rent charge in lieu of  
composition for tithes in said parish do  
hereby signify that it is our intention to  
make application to the Justices at the  
next ensuing Quarter Sessions for the Peace  
to be holden at Carlow in the County of  
Carlow on the 19th day of October 1889 to  
have the average price of corn for the seven  
years preceding ascertained in order that  
such composition may be varied and  
increased or diminished for the ensuing  
seven years in proportion to such average  
price and that the applotment thereof  
may be amended accordingly and the  
rent charges payable in lieu of such  
composition increased or diminished in  
like proportion.
