

Clement Russell Taylor Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years
of the Reign of William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend
three Acts passed in the fourth and fifth and seventh and
eighteenth years of his late Majesty George the Fourth providing
for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland
and to make such compositions permanent for all Tythes arising
growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Stabannon
in the Diocese of Clogher and in the County of South to the
Rector thereof DO hereby certify that the true and just amount
of Compositions for said Rectorial Tythes within the said
Parish is one hundred and eighty pounds of which sum one
hundred and twenty pounds being two thirds thereof is due
and payable to the Vicars Choral of Saint Patrick's Cathedral
and sixty pounds being the remaining third is due and
payable to the Reverend Thomas Parkinson Vicar of said
Parish - And I further certify that the average price of
wheat being the corn principally grown in such Parish
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of
November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is one pound
twelve shillings and one half penny by the Barrel Dated at
Newcastle this 17th day of October 1836
