I Clement Russell Taylor of Newbrook in the

of my Skill and Judgment and according to equity and good
Conscience and without favour or affection prejudice or malice
to any person or persons whatsoever made this appointment
and assessment of the Tythe Compositions upon all Lands
within said Parish equally in proportion and according to
the true Annual Value of the several Lands Given under
my hand this 17th day of October 1836
