The Lord's Proctor and Robert Jones Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain (and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Slabannon and County of Louth) do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Four hundred and ninety eight pounds Ten Shillings by the Year. Of which sum Two hundred and ninety eight pounds Ten Shillings is due and payable to the Vicar Choral of St. Peter's Cathedral in Dublin as Patron of the Parish and Improvitors of two thirds of the Rectorial Tithes, and the remaining sum of Two Hundred pounds by the Year is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Pashinson as Vicar of the Parish and Owner of One third of the Rectorial Tithes and all the Vicarial Tithes of said Parish of Slabannon.

And We do further Certify that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 is £ 1. 15. 8. Late Irish Currency equal to £ 1. 15. 8 present Currency per Barrel
