We Denis Brennan and Robert Innes Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King Geo. the Fourth (intituled an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) do ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yield or payable within the Parish of Stabannon and County of Louth do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and Ninety eight Pounds ten Shillings by the year of which sum Two hundred and Ninety <sup>Eight</sup> Pounds ten Shillings is due and payable to the Vicars Choral of St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin as Patrons of the Parish and Impropriators of two thirds of the Rectorial Tithes and the remaining sum of Two hundred pounds by the year is due and payable to the Rector Tho<sup>s</sup> Robinson as Vicar of the Parish and owner of one third of the Rectorial Tithes and all the Vicarial Tithes of the said Parish of Stabannon - And we do farther Certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 is L<sup>1</sup>.18<sup>s</sup>.8<sup>d</sup> late Currency equal to L<sup>1</sup>.15<sup>s</sup>.8<sup>d</sup> Present Currency per Bushel -
