amt. for the tithe within the 5th parish is £498.10.0 by the year
of which sum £298.10.0 is due payable to the Vicar, Church
of St. John's Dublin as Impropriator of two thirds of the Rect. Tithe
& the vicar of sum of £200 of the year is due of the 1/3rd of the Rect. Tithe & the
Vic. Tithe of the 5th parish. I have also a letter from Mr
Leath the Registrar of the Diocese, corroborating the above of

mistake ^{or} it does not appear that a regular applet-
ment had been made, of the parish, ^{at that period} although the specific
