Two Hundred pounds per Annum is due and payable to  
the Rev. Thos. Dashiell or as Vicar of the above mentioned  
parish of Stabannon

And we do further certify that  
the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally  
grown in such county for the period of seven years ending  
on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1831, is (£1<sup>11</sup> 18<sup>8</sup> 1/2) one pound  
eighteen shillings and 8 pence Irish Currency or £1<sup>11</sup> 15<sup>8</sup> 3/4  
present Currency per barrel
