

Tithe Composition

in the Diocese of Meath } of Tithe Composition for said Parish—

We have summoned before us the several Occupiers of land in the said parish the greater number of whom appeared and were by us examined touching the quantity of land in the Occupation of each and in all instances wherein any plan or survey was laid before us of the Authenticity and accuracy of which we were satisfied, we adopted and made use of same to assist in the survey of the lands—and in all instances wherein no such plan or survey was laid before us, we caused a survey and admeasurement to be made by Mr William O'Brien of the Town of Slane Land Surveyor—and a survey and Admeasurement was also by him made of the public Roads, being the only waste in the parish described by the Statute. We thus ascertained the gross quantity of land not tithe free, in the parish, to be thirteen hundred and eighty eight Acres, three roods and twenty three perches, and the amount of the quantity of roads to be fourteen Acres two roods and sixteen perches which being subtracted from the aforesaid gross quantity leaves in said parish a neat or nett quantity of thirteen hundred and seventy four Acres, one rood and seven perches subject to the Composition in lieu of tithe. We further inspected and examined the several holdings field by field, and thus we estimated the fair Assessable annual Value of each, and then we duly Apportioned and Assessed the full amount of one hundred and ninety two pounds three shillings and six pence half penny Sterling being the annual amount of Composition in lieu of all Tithes in said parish on the several holdings in said neat quantity of land therein (which is not tithe free) equally in proportion and according to the true annual Value of said several lands the sum to be paid to the Rev^d Brabazon William Disney as Rector Incumbent of said parish commencing on the first day of May last past. One thousand eight hundred and twenty nine as in the following book is particularly set forth and in obedience to the Statute—
