fix a true and just composition for all Tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Madralen in the County of Meath
Do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is One hundred and ninety two
pounds sterling by the year which sum is due
and payable to the Reverend Paragon William
Disney as a composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of said Parish and said
Composition to continue invariable for the
space of twenty one years.

And we further certify that the average price
of Oats being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November 1821 twenty one
is fifteen Shillings and two pence per Barrel
