Fourth, entitled (an Act made for establishing a Composition
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time,) to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes tithing,
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Muckallan
in the County of North Down. Do hereby Certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is One Hundred and ninety two
Pounds Sterling by the year which sum is due and
payable to the Reverend Brabazon William Disney,
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him
as Rector of said Parish, and said Composition to continue
invariable for the space of twenty one years,
Do further Certify that the average price
of Cals being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending on the
first day of November 1821. twenty one is fifteen
Shillings and two pence per Barrel.
