pursuance of an act passed in the second & third year of his
present Majesty, entitled an act of Parliament to amend three
acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth, & in the seventh
& eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth
providing for the establishing of Compositions of Tithes in
Ireland. & to make such Compositions permanent, Samuel B
Blackhall of Colanbar in the County of Longford being seized in fee
simple of all that & three thousand of Clonsillaugh
Bigharee & Bigharee Town & Bigharee Ballygoal Ballywoodan
& Ballywoodan Colanbar Ballywoodan Ballywoodan
& Ballywoodan the lands
& bounds whereof are as follows, that is to say bounded on the
North by the Parish of G. on the East by Killycotton on
the West by the Parish of Edgeworthstown & on the South
by Killmore.

hereby require you to grant me a Certificate in writing conformable
to the provisions of said act, declaring me entitled to the Benefit of
this notice, & to perform the other matters on your part required by
said act to be done.
