by the year which sum of Forty Pounds
is due & payable to the
Reverend Richard Baxter as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial Tithes
of said Parish

And I do further certify that the average Price of
Oats being the main produce grown in such
County for the Period of seven years ending the
First day of November 1830 is Thirteen Shillings
& three pence three farthings & three
